At the same time that we live in an increasingly connected world, at the same time that we describe our planet as a "global will are" where inhabitants village" whose inhabitants can communicate with each other with one "click", we leave many local communities cut off from the basics services that significantly determine their



standard of living. This category includes medical services. The fact that communities of our Municipality, such as the villages of Petroto, Mesaio, Philadelphia, Neochorouda, Pentalofos, have difficult access to the city cannot mean that they will be deprived of the critical medical care they so desperately need. The "RemoteCARE" cross-border program in which we participate as a Lead Beneficiary comes to overcome geographical barriers, not only to provide the necessary medical and pharmaceutical services to the residents of these areas, but also to remove the feeling of isolation of these people that has prevailed for years. This goal will be achieved through the development of fully equipped mobile medical units that will visit patients at regular intervals and record their history and data.
